### Job Search Services

For claimants who are medically stable and unable to return to their pre-accident employer. Services include vocational testing, job identification, labour market research, educational feasibility, informational interviews, research, resume writing, cover letters, interview skills, job search techniques, job placement and follow up.

### Job Focus Assessment (JFA)

The results of this assessment identify three viable employment opportunities that are available for claimants near their residence. These jobs are based on the claimant's current skills, physical and cognitive capabilities, occupational interests and previous work experience. All jobs identified will meet claimant's commensurate level.



### Labour Market Analysis (LMA)

A Vocational Rehabilitation Specialist completes a wage survey by contacting local employers. This report can be used for a variety of functions including identifying occupations that are at a claimant's commensurate level or to help claimants set long-term wage recovery goals.

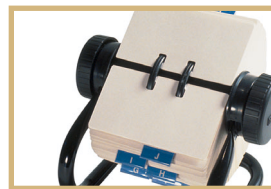
